## Mrs. Dora Urban

Mrs. Herman (Dora) Urban passed away Tuesday evening, March 6th, at a hospital in Jamestown, N. D., following a lingering illness from a heart ailment. The remains were brought to Groton for burial.

Funeral services were held at the Paetznick Funeral Home, Saturday, at 2:00 o'clock p. m., with the Rev. W. W. Keller, Lutheran minister of Jamestown officiating. Burial was at the Groton cemetery.
