### **Mrs. Dorothy Voigt Passes of Pneumonia**

Mrs. Dorothy Voigt, who came to Groton in 1881 and with her family settled on land near Groton, passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Clara Farwell, of Ardmore this state, Sunday, where she had made her home for the past 23 years. Undertaker Paetznick went after the body and brought it back to Groton, where funeral services were held today (Wednesday) in the Paetznick funeral home at 2:00 p. m., with Rev. F. E. Wilke conducting the services.

Mrs. Voigt was born at Watertown, Wis, July 5, 1854 and came to this section in 1881, settling near Groton. Her husband died in 1916. Mrs. Voigt was the mother of six children, four of whom are left to mourn her loss. The children are Frank of Mansfield; Edwin of LaGrange, Ind.; Mrs. Farwell of Ardmore, and Hugo of Mansfield. There are also 12 grandchildren and five great grandchildren; two brothers, Julius Schultz of Nausha, Ia., and Albert Schultz of Minneapolis, and a sister, Mrs. August Bretzlaff, of Greene, Ia.

Mrs. Voigt was a member of the Lutheran church of Hot Springs. Following the funeral here the body will be laid to rest in Groton cemetery.
