Milton Von Wald, 82, Groton, died at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center, Aberdeen, Sunday, Aug., 15, 1993.

The funeral was held at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Stratford, Wednesday, Aug. 18, 1993, with the Rev. William Paepke officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery, with arrangements by Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton.
