Arthur A. Voss, 96, Andover area resident passed away Friday at the Bethesda Nursing Home in Webster, where he had resided for the past six years. He was a retired farmer.

Funeral services were held at 2:00 p. m. on Monday, Feb. 23, at the Zion Lutheran Church in Andover with the Rev. Edwin Rumerfield officiating. Burial was in the Andover cemetery.
