FERDINAND WAGE, DECEASED

Ferdinand Wage, whose illness with typhoid fever was mentioned in the Ferny items of last week, died at 1 o'clock Wednesday morning at the hospital, Aberdeen, to which place he had been taken for treatment after being brought to Groton on the 9th of this month.

Deceased was a native of Wisconsin, born in 1861, hence was 44 years of age; came to this county in 1898, and was married the same year. A widow, five children, two brothers and one sister survive him, and they have the sympathy of all in their untimely bereavement.

Funeral services will be held this afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Evangelical church, by Rev. C. W. Zech, and the body will be laid to rest in Union cemetery.
