## Janette Wage

Services for Mrs. William (Janette) Wage, 85, longtime Groton area resident, were Saturday, Feb. 27, at the United Methodist Church in Groton with the Rev. John Maines officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery. The Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel was in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Wage died Wednesday, Feb. 24, at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen.

Casketbearers were Maurice Harry, Robert Lapham, Otho Schaller, John Schinkel, Otto Schinkel and Larry Sombke. The congregation sang "How Great Thou Art"; "Amazing Grace" and "Sweet Hour of Prayer". Mrs. John Gibbs was the organist.

Janette Frederick was born on August 26, 1896, at Hendricks, Minn. As a child she moved to the Ferney-Groton area where she had since resided. She married William Wage December 11, 1918. She was a member of the Merifu Club of Groton, the United Methodist Church, the UMW and the Mary Circle. In October of 1968 Mr. and Mrs. Wage financed the building of the W.A. Wage Memorial Library. It was officially dedicated November 13, 1968.

Survivors include one sister, Elsie Erdman, in Wisconsin.

She was preceded in death by her husband, two sisters and one brother.
