Lillian C. Wehde, 86, Groton, died at the Colonial Manor, Groton, Tuesday, Jan. 25, 1994. The funeral was held at the United Methodist Church, Groton, Friday, Jan. 28, 1994, with the Rev. Dean Trapp officiating.
