Oscar P. Wennock, Former Grotonite Dies in Aberdeen

Oscar P. Wennock, an early resident of the Groton vicinity, died at the hospital in Aberdeen, Saturday, following a brief illness.

Mr. Wennock was 61 years old at the time of his death, being born near Groton on June 28, 1883. He operated a farm north of James for many years, moving to Aberdeen about 24 years ago. Mr. Wennock was a very highly respected citizen and his many local friends and associates knew him only as being honest and dependable in all his transactions.

He is survived by a sister, Miss Amanda Wennock, also a resident of Aberdeen.

Funeral services were held in Aberdeen, Tuesday afternoon, with the Rev. A. Elmer Moe officiating. Burial was made in the Groton cemetery in the family lot.
