Mrs. Eliza B. Wilson Laid To Rest Tues. Afternoon

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday afternoon, at 2:00 o'clock, at the First Presbyterian church in Groton for Elizabeth B. Wilson, 92 who passed away in a hospital at Yankton, Saturday, Dec. 20, 1947, following an illness of about three weeks, due to the "flu" and advanced age. The Rev. H. W. Atkinson, officiated. Burial was made in the Groton Union Cemetery. Pallbearers were Fred Frommel, Chas. E. Adams, Randall Hall, Palmer G. Peterson, G. I. Hargrow and Chas. J. Lundberg.

Mrs. Wilson was born at St. Albans, Vermont, September 16, 1855, and came to Groton about the year of 1881, and in 1885 was united in marriage with Josiah Wilson, who preceded her in death many years ago.

She leaves to mourn her passing, a son, Robert J. Wilson of Denver, Colo.; one sister, Mrs. G. M. L. Erwin, a former resident of Aberdeen, but for the past several years has made her home with a daughter in Fremont, Nebr. She is also survived by several nieces and nephews.

Mrs. Wilson was a member of the Presbyterian church; also the Current Event Club. She was very active in church activities and local affairs of importance; was a true and loving wife and mother, a kind and thoughtful neighbor and friend, and was loved by all who knew her.
