Mrs. S. L. Winans, 81, Laid to Rest Friday P. M.

Funeral services were held for Mrs. S. L. (Linc) Winans on Friday afternoon at the Paetznick Funeral Home with the Rev. L. C. Benson in charge. Mrs. Winans passed away Monday afternoon at her home, where she had been confined for more than two years.
