

**Funeral of Mauvette
Wolfe Is Held Sunday
From Groton Church**

The funeral of Mauvette Wolfe, aged 12, former Groton girl, and grand daughter of F. T. Luce of this vicinity, was held Sunday from the Methodist Episcopal church and interment made in the Groton Union cemetery.

Mauvette was born here and had been living for some time with her mother and stepfather, Mr. and Mrs. J. Stenseth, near Eugene, Oregon.

Last week, Mauvette, accompanied by two girl friends went to wade in a creek, and unknown to their parents, stopped at a mill pond and waded there instead. The three waded out into the pond hand-in-hand, when one of them, believed to be Mauvette, stepped into a hole made by the blowing out of a stump several years ago. All three went down and drowned in a short time. A little boy saw the tragedy, but he was too excited to tell a coherent story. The bodies were found about two hours after the tragedy.

Mauvette was a girl of sweet disposition and was loved by her relatives and idolized by her little friends and her untimely tragic death has cast a shadow of sorrow over Groton.
