Telegraphic word from Hettinger brought news of the tragic death of Thomas Worthy, who met death thro' gas or suffocation in a well forty-five feet deep in which he was at work.

Details of the tragedy are very meagre, but sufficient to produce a startling sensation here and at Huffton where the young man, who is under 25 years of age, has resided since infancy.

A year or so ago he was married here and had gone west to make for himself and wife a home. Was engaged in this laudable undertaking when his career was brought so suddenly to an end. His family have the deepest sympathy in their bereavment, especially the wife, who is left with a baby just a few weeks old.
