## Fred Zoellner

Funeral services for Fred O. Zoellner, 79, rural Groton, were held at 10 a.m. Wednesday, June 13, at St. John's Catholic Church in Groton with the Rev. Marvin McPhee officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery.

A scriptural wake service was held at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel.

Mr. Zoellner died Sunday, June 10, at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen.
