Otto J. Zoellner

Services for Otto J. Zoellner, Groton were held Saturday, Dec. 19, at 2 p. m. at the Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Robert Carey officiating. Mr. Zoellner died last Tuesday at St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen. He was 77.

Burial was in the Groton cemetery. The Groton American Legion Post conducted graveside military rites. Pall bearers were Clarence Von Wald, Donald Von Wald, Milton Von Wald, Allen Zoellner, Earl Zoellner and Elmer Zoellner.

Mr. Zoellner was born Jan. 31, 1887 at Rocksberry, Wis. He was married to Christina Von Wald, March 19, 1924, in Aberdeen. He had lived in Groton for 57 years.

Survivors include his widow; two sons, Richard and Robert, both of rural Groton; one brother, Fred, Groton; and seven grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by four brothers, four sisters and one grandchild.
