Robert "Bob" Zoellner, 66, Groton, died Friday, Oct. 1, 1993 at St. Luke's Midland Regional Center, Aberdeen.

The funeral was held at the First Presbyterian Church, Groton, Tuesday, Oct. 5, 1993, with the Rev. Richard Geiger officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery, with military rites by the Groton American Legion Post #39. A prayer service was held at the Paetznick Garness Funeral Chapel, Monday evening.

Robert Otto Zoellner was born August 12, 1927 to Otto and Christina (Von Wald) Zoellner, rural Groton. He grew up on a farm and attended rural schools near Groton. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean conflict.
