

MINUTES FOR THE CITY OF GROTON LOCAL BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

The City of Groton Board of Equalization met in regular session on Tuesday, March 19, 2019 at 8:00 pm at the Groton Community Center. Board members present were Mayor Scott Hanlon, Council members: David Blackmun, Shirley Wells, Jay Peterson, and Burt Glover. Also present was Hope Block, Finance Officer, Paul Kosel and Doug Sombke.

There was one written notice of appeal in objection to property assessments presented by Doug Sombke. Sombke was concerned that his property increase was too high compared to that of his neighbors and the average increases on other residential properties. The Groton City Council deferred the decision to Brown County with their reappraisal of the property to be completed March 22nd, 2019.

No one else was present on March 19th to object to assessments. The board reviewed the property assessment list and recommended that Brown County review the following property valuations: Lot 17 Bk 10 orig plat, Lt 17-18 Bk 21 1st add, Lt 1-2 Bk 25 1st add, and N 32' Lt11 & Lt 12 Bk 57 3rd add as increases seemed to be unwarranted.

The Groton City Local Board of Equalization adjourned at 9:26pm on a motion by Wells and seconded by Glover. All members present voted aye.
