W. I. AGNEW DEAD

W. I. Agnew died at his home in Aberdeen, Wash., on May 18th. This item of news was contained in a letter from J. M. Burns of Sumner, Wash.

Mr. Agnew was long a resident of Groton, engaged in the practice of law and in the real estate business, associated with W. I. Erwin as Erwin & Agnew.

He moved to the state of Washington many years ago and attained to considerable prominence in the legal profession in that state. While here he had quite an extensive law practice in Brown, Day and Marshall counties. For a time after leaving here he was located in Olympia, the Washington capital, later moving to Aberdeen.

Mr. Burns also notes a recent call from Ed. Story, an old Grotonite, formerly located at Chehalis and now living at Tacoma, Wash.
