The M. R. Albrights Both Die Within Week

Mr. and Mrs. Milton R. Albright, who resided in Groton for several years with their family, both died within a week of one another, according to word reaching Groton friends through Don Albright, their eldest son, now of Rapid City. Mrs. Albright died on April 4 and her husband on the following Friday.

No details of Mrs. Albright's sudden passing are available, although it was known that Mr. Albright was stricken with tuberculosis last summer and was being treated at the Black Hills sanitarium at the time of his death. Recent reports indicated that he was making excellent progress toward recovery.
