Mrs. Adolph (Ella M.) Anderson, 74, Aberdeen resident who had been living at the Blume Rest Home in Redfield, died last Wednesday afternoon in the Americana Nursing Home in Aberdeen.

Services were held at the Gates Funeral Home Saturday, March 13 at 2 p.m. with the Rev. W.J. Leyh of Ipswich officiating. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens.
