## F. N. ANDERSON

Funeral services for F. N. Anderson, 77, pioneer farmer of Gem Township, were held at 2:30 p. m., Thursday at the Johnson Funeral Home, in Aberdeen. The Rev. Edgar Streufert officiated. Burial was in Riverside cemetery.

Mr. Anderson died Sunday afternoon at St. Luke's hospital, following an extended illness.

He was born March 24, 1876, at Clarence, Iowa. As a young boy he moved with his parents to Atlantic, Iowa. In February, 1905, he married Minnie Runte of Matlock, Iowa. The couple moved to South Dakota in 1909 and had lived on the same farm since.

He was a member of the Lutheran church and had been on the school board for many years.

In addition to his wife, survivors include a son, Ray, Aberdeen; daughter, Mrs. Floyd Trask, Groton; three brothers, George of Cheyenne, Wyo., Bruce of Divide, Wyo., Ross of Sparta, Mo.; and five grandchildren.
