Norman Anderson

(October 19, 1929 - May 14, 2020)

Clark, SD: Norman L. Anderson, 90 of Clark, formerly of Pierpont and Groton, SD, passed away Thursday, May 14, 2020 at Roetell Assisted Living Center in Clark.



Due to the current restrictions of the COVID19 pandemic, there will be no funeral service. Graveside rites will be held at the Falnes Cemetery of rural Langford, with Pastor Paul Kosel officiating.

Norman Leroy Anderson was born October 19, 1929 in Pierpont, SD to Severt Mandius and Selma Pauline (Liknes) Anderson. As a child, he attended country schools in the Pierpont area. His family moved to Roosevelt, OR where his father worked at a factory for the war effort. Norman graduated from Roosevelt High School in 1947.

After completing his education, Norman joined the U. S. Navy. During his 20 years of military service, he made his home on eight different war ships. He was deployed in the West Pacific, Korea, Vietnam and the Marshall Islands during the atomic bomb testing. Following his honorable discharge, Norman settled in Westminster, CA where he worked as a letter

carrier for the US Postal Service until his retirement.

Later in life, Norman returned to his roots in South Dakota. He made his home in Pierpont, Gresham, OR before moving to Groton. His final months were spent at Roetell Assisted Living Center in Clark.

Norman was extremely proud of his service to his country during two wars. He was awarded a number of medals, including the National Defense Service Medal, the Good Conduct Medal, the Viet Nam Service Medal, and a Navy Unit Commendation. He was a Life Member of the American Legion, Fleet Reserve and the VFW, and also belonged to Heaven Bound Ministries of Pierpont. In his spare time Norman loved to build models, and considered himself a “struggling artist” with his oil painting.

Survivors include three daughters, two grandsons, a granddaughter and two great-granddaughters.

Preceding him in death were his parents and seven siblings.
