Frederick C. Arndt, Jr.

Frederick Carl Arndt, Jr., was born in Leola on Aug. 9, 1895, son of Mrs. Frederick Carl Arndt. His early education was at Leola and Northern Normal at Aberdeen. His first position was with Ward Candy Co., as salesman of which he was part owner. He entered the service of his country on Oct. 15, 1918. He was in the 10th Corp of the Army. On April 15, 1918, he married June Sliter of Aberdeen, in South Dakota. He was discharged in 1919 at Camp Dodge, Iowa. Following his discharge he managed a general store in Leola. In 1921 he opened the Sears Roebuck store in Sioux Falls, as manager. He remained with Sears 10 years serving as district and dist. manager. After leaving his connection with Sears he became dist. sales manager with Western Drug at Dallas, Texas, for 2 years. In 1933 he went to Des Moines, Iowa, and operated his own miscellaneous business in which he was engaged until Dec. 18, 1960 when he suffered a heart attack from which he passed away on Feb. 2, 1961.

He leaves to mourn his passing, a wife, Mildred; one son, Nicholas Frederick Arndt and 3 grandchildren.
