Services for Robert Bradshaw, 82, Portland, Ore., former Groton area resident were held at 2 p. m., Monday, July 3, at the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel.

Mr. Bradshaw, who lived in the Groton area until 1940 died Thursday in Portland.

The Rev. Gordon Buchholz officiated and burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.
