### ADOLPH BRUMMOND

Funeral services were conducted last Thursday by the Rev. G. Bohn of the Hanson Lutheran church for Adolph Brummund of Reeder, N. D., but for many years a resident of this community.

Adolph Brummond was a native of Lindenwald, West Prussia, Germany, and was born there on January 11, 1879. He came to America at about 16 years of age and settled in Sibley county, Minnesota, not far from Gibbon. When he came to South Dakota in 1894 he made his home with the Carl Krueger family, working at his trade as a carpenter. About thirty years ago he removed to North Dakota where he made his home at Reeder by reason of property interests.

His death was quite unexpected, although he had sought medical aid shortly before his death. The end came suddenly and he was found dead in his room on July 9th. Physicians ascribed death to heart failure.

The remains were brought to Groton from the North Dakota town which had been his home and the body was laid to rest in Ferney Lutheran cemetery, following a service at the Paetz-nick Funeral home.
