

Sybil Cutler, 96

Mrs. Howard (Sybil) Cutler, 96, Claremont, died Wednesday, May 11, 1994 at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center, Aberdeen.

Her funeral was Saturday, May 14, 1994 at the United Methodist Church, Claremont, with the Rev. James Cissell officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery, with Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton, in charge of arrangements.

A prayer service was held at the church, Friday night.

Sybil Bibler was born March 4, 1898 to Sam and Lillian (Snyder) Bibler in Chicago. They lived in Chicago for two years. The family then moved to Bringhurst, Ind., and later to Buckingham, Ill. She attended grade school in Buckingham and went to high school in Kankakee, Ill. After graduating, she went to summer school at Normal, Ill. She got her teacher's certificate and taught four years in Buckingham and one year in Momence, Ill.

She married Howard W. Cutler in Kankakee, Ill., June 29, 1922. They moved to his farm at Claremont, and farmed for 56 years. He died in 1978. She moved into Claremont, where she made her home.

She kept a diary for more than 70 years. She loved to travel, and visited all 50 states, traveled to Europe and the Holy Land.

She was a member of the United Methodist Church, Claremont; Royal Neighbors Lodge; Huffton Election Board for many years and served on the school board.

She is survived by four sons, Keith Cutler, Dale Cutler, Verl Cutler and Lyle Cutler, all of Claremont; two daughters, Mrs. Ron (Ann) Carver, Marshall, Minn., and Mrs. Bill (Mary Lynn) James, Houghton; 27 grandchildren and 61 great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and one sister.
