FARGO, N.D. - Daryl K. Danielson, 57, Fargo, and formerly of Aberdeen, died Monday, Jan. 11, 1988, in Fargo of natural causes.

His funeral was held Friday in Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Fargo with the Rev. Alfred Thiem officiating. Burial will be in Groton Union Cemetery at a later date.

Daryl K. Danielson was born January 6, 1931, in Aberdeen to Kenneth and Elma (Swearingen) Danielson. He graduated from Central High School and later from North Dakota State School of Science at Wahpeton. He then worked at the Groton Ford Garage. He served in the Air Force during the Korean Conflict.

On October 25, 1952, he married Ardis Schuelke in Groton. After his discharge in 1955, they returned to Groton where he worked for the Ford Garage. He then worked for Mobil Oil as the training station manager in Aberdeen and in Sioux Falls.

In 1961 he went to work for

Chevrolet Motor Division in Mandan and Bismarck, N. D. They moved to West Fargo in 1967 and to Sioux Falls in 1973. In 1977 he became the Fargo zone claims administrator for Chevrolet, retiring in 1986. He was working as quality control manager for Gateway Chevrolet, Fargo, at the time of his death.

Survivors include his wife; one son, Bryan K., Fargo; one daughter, Debra Danielson, Seattle, Wash.; his mother, Fargo; and one sister, Mrs. John B. (Dona) Burckhard, Aberdeen. He was preceded in death by his father.
