Funeral Services Held For Former Stratford Couple

Belle R. Dennis

Funeral services for Belle R. Dennis, 84, were held February 22, in the First Lutheran church of Circle, Mont., Rev. C. A. Carlson, officiating. Interment was in Riverview cemetery.

Mrs. Dennis fell on January 29th in her home, breaking the bone in her left leg, just below the hip and until the time of her death was a patient at McCone County Hospital in Circle. Her husband died of a heart attack soon after she fell.

Mrs. Dennis was born May 15th, 1877 in Arena, Wis. On Sept. 13, 1899, she was united in marriage to George Dennis at Mazomanie, Wis. To this union three sons were born, Byron and Russell, who preceded her in death, and Joseph W. of Dodgeville, Wis.

In 1907 the family moved to the Groton and Stratford vicinity, where they adopted a daughter, now Mrs. Hazel Thieman of Lake Park, Iowa.

In 1920 they moved to Montana, where they farmed in the Mayberry community. They retired in 1951, moving to Circle, where they since made their home.

Mrs. Dennis was a faithful member of the First Lutheran church of Circle.

Survivors include one son, Joseph of Dodgeville, Wis., their daughter, Mrs. Hazel Thieman, Lake Park, Ia., one sister, Mrs. Newt Bate, Isabelle, S. D. and a brother, Stanley Rogers, Seattle, Wash., four grand children and six great grandchildren.
