Funeral services for George Dennis, 87, of Circle, were held Friday, Feb. 2, at 2:00 p. m. from the First Lutheran church in Circle, with the Rev. C. A. Carlson officiating.

Mrs. Helen Waller sang "Abide With Me" and "Near to the Heart of God," accompanied by Mrs. Hertha Hilstad on the organ.

Interment was in the Riverview cemetery at Circle.

George Dennis passed away suddenly of a heart attack at his home in Circle, Monday morning, January 29, 1962.

Mr. Dennis, a retired farmer, was born in Livona, Indiana, on September 15, 1874.

With his parents, as a child, he moved to Darlington, Wis., and later to Mazomanie, Wis.

On September 13, 1899, he was united in marriage to Belle Rogers, at Mazomanie. To this union were born three sons, Byron and Russell, both of whom have preceded him in death, and Joseph W. of Dodgeville, Wis. In 1907 the family moved to the vicinity of Groton and Stratford, S. D., where they dopted a daughter, now Mrs. Hazel Thieman of Lake Park, Iowa. In 1922 they moved to Montana, where they farmed in the Mayberry community. They retired and moved to Circle in 1951, where they since made their home. For many years Mr. Dennis regularly attended the First Lutheran church in Circle.

Surviving are Joseph, of Dodgeville, Wis., and their daughter, Mrs. Hazel Thieman of Lake Park, Iowa, four grandchildren and six great grandchildren.
