## John Dickerson Dies While on Way to the Coast for His Health

John Dickerson, pioneer Dakotan and well known in this part of the state, succumbed at Santa Fe, N. M., as the result of several months of falling health, according to word received by relatives and friends here. Mr. Dickerson had been in Santa Fe for the past three weeks, where he went from Denver, Col. He left the state some time ago on his western trip in an attempt to regain his health.

The body will be brought back to Aberdeen for burial and will arrive on the Northwestern railway late Wednesday evening. No funeral arrangements have been made as yet until the family can hear from other relatives.

Mr. Dickerson has lived in Aberdeen for many years and has been a Dakotan practically all his life. He leaves a multitude of friends here and throughout the state to mourn his loss.—Journal.
