### JESSE E. DIXON

Jesse E. Dixon passed away at the Groton hospital Friday, following a siege of pneumonia which had lasted for about ten days. He was working on the Roy Rix place at the time he was taken ill and he was brought to the Groton hospital, at that time suffering from the grippe. This developed into a case of pneumonia, and he never rallied following the attack. At the time of death he was sixty-five years of age. Mr. Dixon had come to South Dakota about a year ago, from Port Byron, N. Y. He is survived by two brothers and three sisters, who reside in New York, with the exception of one sister, resident in Elkhart, Ind. He also leaves Robt. and George Dixon here, cousins. Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon from the Deidrich undertaking parlors, Rev. T. R. Taggart officiating, with interment in Groton Union cemetery.
