Funeral services were conducted at West Hanson Lutheran Church for Edwin J. Dobberpuhl, 64, on Friday, June 6, at 2:00 p. m., with the Rev. V. M. Goeglein officiating. Mr. Dobberpuhl passed away June 3, 1958, at the Aberdeen hospital, following an extended illness.

The deceased was born Jan. 22, 1894, in Brown County and on June 3, 1919, was united in marriage to Augusta Nehls in the West Hanson parsonage. They were members of that congregation. Mr. Dobberpuhl spent his entire life in this vicinity, where he was engaged in farming.

Surviving are his widow, Augusta; a daughter, Mrs. Donald (LaVerle) Fletcher of Aberdeen; four sons, Floyd, Donald and Eugene of Verdon and James of Aberdeen; two brothers, Emil, of Jacksonville, Fla., and Erwin of Boise, Idaho.
