Henry Dodge passed away Tuesday morning in St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen, after a long illness at the age of 75 years, 2 months and 10 days. He was born May 17, 1889 to John and Mary Dodge in Cambria, Wis. In 1909, he came with his parents to Lead, S. D. On June 4, 1917, he married Esther Kishner. To this union four children were born.

In 1949, they retired from farming and moved to the Groton vicinity. He leaves to mourn his passing his wife, a son, Willard of Philip; a daughter, Mrs. Robert (Arvilla) Murray of Lead; a sister, Jennie Lyons of Sioux Falls; and 8 grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Friday, August 7, 1964 at the Methodist church in Groton with the Rev. K. Oliver officiating. Music was provided by Misses Myrtle and Margaret Anderson who sang, "The Old Rugged Cross," and "In the Garden," accompanied by Mrs. Ben Anderson, pianist.
