Elizabeth Williams Dunning died of cancer June 8, 1989 at her home in San Diego, Calif. A memorial service was held June 26 at the Rancho Bernardo Community Presbyterian Church.

Betty Williams was born to Frances and Joe Williams, Groton, February 9, 1923. She attended grade school and high school in Groton, and then the University of South Dakota, where she was a member of Kappa Alpha Theta sorority.

After graduating from college she worked for some years for a management-consulting firm in Chicago. She married Donald D. Dunning, a native of Sioux Falls, October 20, 1951, and they lived in

Niles, Mich. When her husband was sent to Toronto to establish a branch of the Kawneer Company there, they moved to Willowdale, Ontario, where they lived for 10 years. They moved to Rancho Bernardo in 1972.

Active in local Theta alumnae groups and PEO chapters, Betty had recently been honored for her service on Rancho Bernardo Golf Club committees.

She is survived by her husband, her daughters, Julie Dunning, Los Angeles, and Ann Dunning Shute, Santa Barbara, her son, David Dunning, Toronto, and her brother Robert Neff Williams, New York City.
