Services for Mrs. Clarence V. (Mae) Edwards, 79, former Groton and Aberdeen resident, who died Monday at Walker Methodist Home in Minneapolis, were held Wednesday, Nov. 15 at the Huebl Funeral Chapel in Aberdeen, with Dr. Francis V. Tannehill of the First Methodist Church officiating.
