## Carl L. Funk

William C. Funk of this city, received the sad news of the death of his brother, Carl L. Funk, 72, in a Minneapolis, Minn., hospital, New Year's eve. He had been ill for a long time, following an auto accident.

The deceased, son of Mr. and Mrs. H. C. Funk, resided in Groton with his parents from 1882 to 1897, when the family, with the exception of William C., moved to Wisconsin.

Mr. Funk was preceded in death by his wife eight years ago. They had no children. Relatives of his wife had been caring for him during his illness.

Funeral services were held for the departed at Minneapolis. William C. Funk was unable to attend because of illness in his family.

Funeral services were held on Friday, Jan. 4, at 1:00 p. m., at the Werneess Brothers Chapel in Minneapolis for Carl L. Funk, 72, who passed away on December 31, at a hospital in Minneapolis. Burial was in Lakewood cemetery.

Mr. Funk was born at Fox Lake, Wis., on April 12, 1879, son of Mr. and Mrs. H. C. Funk. He will be remembered by a few as a grocery clerk here in Groton, until his parents moved to Beaver Dam, Wis., where he resided many years and married Miss Agnes Maguire of Beaver Dam. They moved to Renville, Minn., where he opened a harness shop, but the grocery line was his choice of occupation, so he started a grocery store on Lake Street in Minneapolis, which he and his wife operated for several years until sickness in the family required them to sell out. Later he worked for the Grenneau Cake Corp., whom he served for 14 years until he and his wife were victims of a bad auto accident, which disabled him for many years.

His wife preceded him in death about eight years ago. There were no children. His brother, Wm. C. Funk, resides in Groton.
