## Mrs. Morris A. Graves

Funeral services for Mrs. Morris A. Graves, 36, Bath, who died at the Aberdeen hospital, were held at the Gates Funeral Home, Aberdeen, at 2:00 p. m., Monday of last week, with the Rev. Standish MacIntosh officiating. Burial was in the Bath cemetery.

Evelyn Mary Pegler was born in Aberdeen, Scotland, on April 19, 1913. She was married to Morris A. Graves in London, England on Sept. 1st, 1945. She had been a resident of Bath for the past four years. Mrs. Graves helped organize and was the first president of the local Overseas Wives Club.
