Manley Green, 78, Groton, died September 5, 2002, at Avera St. Lukes Hospital, Aberdeen. His funeral will be held Monday, Sept. 9, 10:30 a.m., at Augustana Lutheran Church, rural Claremont. The Rev. Jeff Redlin will officiate. Burial will follow in Augustana Lutheran Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton .
