Mrs. Robert (Mabel) Haire, 91, longtime Brown County resident, died Monday, Jan. 17, at the Bethesda Home of Aberdeen.

Services were held at 2 p.m., Thursday, Jan. 20, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, 423 3rd Ave. S.E., with the Rev. J.E. Murphy officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.

Casketbearers were Bill Grotlushen, Kent, Minn.; Gordon Sieh, Leola; Clifford Padley, Marvin Dombrowe and Dale Hosley, all of Aberdeen; and Jean Ries, John Sieh and Lonnie Daly, all of Groton.

Mabel Sieh was born April 6, 1891, at James, S.D. She graduated from Aberdeen Central High School in 1910 and received her teaching certificate from Northern State College in 1911. She taught in the Putney School in 1911-12. She married Robert Joseph Haire November 27, 1913 at the Presentation Convent. Father Robert Haire, who was an uncle of the groom officiated. They made their home on the family homestead near Putney for many years. When Mr. Haire died in 1950 she moved to Aberdeen where she had since resided. She was a member of the Altar Society and the Catholic Research Club. She was also a member of the Royal Neighbors of America and was an officer of the Brown County Territorial Pioneers.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Jack (Angela) Boos, Rancho Santa Fe, Calif.; and Mrs. Clarence (Rachel) Dye, Las Cruces, N.M.; two sisters, Mrs. Thomas (Rose) McNarama, New Richmond, Wis.; and Mrs. J.C. (Leone) Corcoran, St. Paul, Minn.; three grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband and one son.
