## MRS. JAMES HARGROW DIES

A recurrence of kidney trouble caused George Hargrow to take his mother to St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen on Friday last. Her condition was too serious to permit an operation, and death came as a gracious relief from her sufferings early Tuesday morning. Funeral services will be held today from the home of her daughter, Mrs. M. Cavanaugh of Bath, and from the Catholic Church in Aberdeen.
