## George J. Hasse

George J. Hasse, retired farmer of the Warner area, and a resident of Groton, died at St. Luke's hospital in Aberdeen early Thursday morning. Funeral services were held at the Huebl chapel in Aberdeen at 2:00 p. m., Saturday, with the Rev. Dr. Harold G. Trost and the Rev. Charles W. Zech, Watertown, officiating. Burial was in the Riverside cemetery.

Mr. Hasse was born on July 16, 1869, near St. Charles, Minn., where he spent his childhood and youth. When he was 15 years of age he moved with his parents to a homestead near Warner. He farmed near there for many years. On October 22, 1895, he was married to Alvina L. Merten at Aberdeen. They farmed near Warner until 1909 when they moved to Aberdeen. In 1915 they returned to the farm near Warner and remained there until their retirement in 1944, when they again moved to Aberdeen, and four years ago moved to Groton to make their home.

Survivors, besides his wife, are two sons, Royal and Merten Hasse, both of Aberdeen, and seven grandchildren. Three brothers, two sisters, and one son preceded him in death.
