

Ellen Heitmann ⁷⁻¹⁸⁻⁹⁰

Ellen Heitmann, age 84, died on July 6, 1990, at her home in Groton where she had resided all of her life.

The funeral was July 9, 1990 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Methodist Church of Groton with burial at Groton Union. The Rev. Dean Trapp officiated.

Born March 6, 1906, to Elmer and Hannah Johnson (deceased) in Groton, Ellen married Bill Heitmann on September 26, 1940, in Webster, S.D.
