## Marlis Hitchcock

Services for Marlis Maureen Hitchcock, 19, Verdon, were held at 2 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 26, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Ferney with the Rev. Edwin Rumerfield officiating. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens near Aberdeen.

Miss Hitchcock died early Friday morning at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen from injuries received in a two-car accident one mile west of Webster on Thanksgiving Day.

The church choir sang "Asleep in Jesus" and "I'm But A Stranger Here," accompanied by Mrs. Dallas Sombke, organist.
