Mrs. Kenneth Holum

Services for Mrs. Kenneth (Solveig) Holum, 55, of Washington, D. C., formerly of Groton, were held Thursday, January 22, at the local Emmanuel Lutheran Church. The Rev. Diedrik Nelson officiated. Burial was in the Groton cemetery.

Pall bearers were Mrs. Holum's five sons, Kenneth Jr., Charles, Knute, John and Robert and son-in-law, John Whitson.

Music was provided by Mrs. Kenneth Alberts, organist, and congregational singing.

Mrs. Holum died Saturday at Washington, D. C. A memorial service was held Monday evening in Washington.

Mrs. Holum was born April 20, 1914 at Merrill, Wis., attended school at Merrill and Perry, Wis., and graduated from Augustana College in Sioux Falls. She was married to Kenneth Holum at Baltic on March 17, 1937. They farmed near Groton until 1960. The family moved to Washington, D. C., in 1961, where Mr. Holum was Assistant Secretary of the Interior for Power and Water.

Survivors include her husband; one daughter, Mrs. John (Margaret) Whitson, China Lake, Calif.; and five sons, Kenneth Holum Jr., Chicago, Ill., and John, Robert, Charles and Knute Holum, all of Washington, D. C.
