Martin Huber, 75, Groton, died Wednesday, April 20, 1994 at Colonial Manor, Groton.

His funeral Mass was Saturday, April 23, 1994 at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church, Groton, with the Rev. Albert Cizewski and the Rev. Ken Bain officiating.
