## Charles Jaeschke

The community was saddened to hear of the death Monday, Feb. 2, 1953, of Charles Jaeschke, Sr., 82, at the Aberdeen hospital. Although in failing health for some time, he was seriously ill only a short time, entering the hospital Sunday.

The deceased, born July 19, 1870, in Wisconsin, was united in marriage to Emma Dahme on March 13, 1898. Mr. Jaeschke was a retired farmer, following that vocation for the past 65 years in Gem township, southwest of Groton, where he made his home on the homestead with his son, Albert. Mrs. Jaeschke preceded him in death on May 2, 1952.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Sarah Reber; three sons, Edward of Aberdeen, Charles and Albert of Groton, besides a number of grandchildren and one great grandchild.

Funeral services will be held Thursday at 2:00 p. m., at the James Lutheran church, with the Rev. LaMar Miller officiating. Burial will be in the Groton cemetery.
