## Former Groton Girl Goes to Final Reward

Miss Hazel Janike, a former Groton girl, who had been making her home at Yankton for some time past and who is a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Paul Janike of this city, died at Yankton last Friday, following an illness from which she has been suffering for the past several years.

Miss Janike was born at Pierpont, August 8, 1900, and was about 31 years of age at the time of her death. A brother, Clyde, died during the flu epidemic of 1918.

The body was brought to Groton and the funeral held from St. John's Lutheran church Tuesday afternoon, and the remains laid to rest in Groton cemetery. Rev. F. E. Wilke conducted the funeral services.
