Services for Hilmer E. Johnson, 76, Claremont, were held at 2 p. m., Friday at the Augustana Lutheran Church south of Claremont. The Rev. Albert Hemming officiated. Burial was in the Groton cemetery.

Mr. Johnson, a farmer, died last Tuesday at the Britton hospital after an extended illness.

He was born in Sweden in 1885 and was married to Augusta Carlson, Dec. 30, 1913, at Claremont.

He came to Conde in 1887, moving to the Claremont community in 1900 and had lived there since that time. He was a member of the Augustana Lutheran church.
