Another Progressive Farmer Lost to Groton Through Influenza.

Ernest Lindstrom passed away at his home northeast of the city last Saturday, following an attack of influenza which developed into pneumonia. While he had been in the community but a short time, he was rapidly forging to the front as a farmer, and he will be missed in this enterprise.

Ernest Lindstrom was born March 12, 1887, in Ruda, Sweden. He came to the United States in 1905 and first settled at Rockford, Ill., and from there moved to Groton three years ago. He engaged in farming up to the time of his death which occurred on Saturday, Dec. 7. Pneumonia was the cause.

He leaves to mourn his untimely death Gust of Groton, and one brother and three sisters, who still reside in Sweden. Both parents having died a number of years ago.
