The funeral for Mary Matthews, 81, Groton, was held at 10 a.m., Thursday, May 24, at the United Methodist Church, Groton, with the Rev. John Maines officiating.

Mrs. Matthews died Monday, May 21, at the Colonial Manor, Groton.
