BRITTON - The funeral for Anna McLaughlin, 91, Britton, was held at the United Methodist Church in Britton. The Rev. Doug Diehl officiated.

She died Wednesday, Oct. 18, 1989, at Colonial Manor Nursing Home at Groton.

Anna Motl was born February 9, 1898, in southern Minnesota to Joe and Josie (Rysana) Motl. The family moved to Kidder when she was a small child. She married Lloyd McLaughlin September 17, 1919, at Britton.

She worked as a clerk in Abbas Variety Store at Britton. She later worked at Velsa Carter Dress Shop and Schumacher Furniture at Britton. She moved to Groton where she lived with her son, LaVerl and Maureen McLaughlin, for the past five and one-half years. In May 1989, she moved into the Colonial Manor Nursing Home at Groton.

She was a member of United Methodist Church, Sunshine Club and American Legion Auxiliary since 1930.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband in 1964, one infant son, three grandchildren, two brothers and one sister.
